Land Stewardship Grant:

Carla reported on the ALMS conference that she & Patti attended. October 31 is the deadline for application for Land Stewardship Grants. Alberta Conservation may be doing a drone riparian assessment of Lake Isle this year.

Bernie is going to apply for 2 separate grants of \$15,000 each:

- one for drone fly overs for both lakes and/or riparian assessment & restoration or just for Lac Ste. Anne if Lake Isle is already done by Alberta Conservation
- one for dealing with the flowering rush in Lake Isle in whatever manner is deemed the best
